

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE TERM/SEMESTER

Withdrawal refers to withdrawal from all classes for the term/semester. This procedure is not to be confused with dropping a single course or several courses (see the explanation for dropping courses (<https://catalog.uwplatt.edu/graduate/registration-course-policies/registration/#dropping-courses>)). Please consult with your advisor regarding procedures.

Students may withdraw from the term/semester through the published deadline (the eighth week of a fall or spring semester). A late withdrawal from the term/semester may be requested through the last day of classes but prior to final exams.

If a student is prevented from a timely withdrawal from the term/semester because of accident, injury, military duty, or other extraordinary circumstances, an extraordinary withdrawal from the term/semester may be permitted. If the withdrawal is due to medical or behavioral health reasons, please refer to the medical withdrawal policy (<https://catalog.uwplatt.edu/graduate/academic-policies/medical-withdrawal/>).
