

CHEMISTRY MINOR

The chemistry minor is designed to provide a broader background and chemistry perspective for students in other majors, including those preparing to teach middle-school or high-school science. In order to be licensed to teach science, students must complete the Science Education Major (<https://catalog.uwplatt.edu/undergraduate/liberal-arts-education/environmental-sciences-and-society/science-education-bs/>). This major requires students to acquire depth in a science discipline via completion of a 2nd major or minor, such as the Chemistry Minor.
