

GERMAN MAJOR, B.A.

The major requires a total of 36 credits with a minimum of 20 credits selected from courses numbered 3000 or higher. GERMAN 4220 and GERMAN 3530 are required. Students who major in German must have a grade point average of no lower than a 2.50 in the German courses they take, and meet the education abroad requirement by completing eight to nine credits in our Education Abroad program at the 3000-4000 level. Similar or comparable cultural experiences could also be accepted.

In addition, **students completing a Bachelor of Arts degree** are required to take nine credits of English literature and philosophy with no more than two courses from each area (2000 level or above).
